DISPOSAL OF FIREPLACE ASHES

old season is upon us and it is very important to dispose of fireplace ashes properly to prevent a fire. Never put fireplace ashes in a trash container because it can easily ignite. Do not remove hot ashes from a fireplace immediately. Wait 2-3 days until they are completely cool and there are no hot embers remaining. If you have to remove the ashes from the fireplace before they are completely cool, put the ashes and remaining hot embers in a metal bucket. Move the bucket outside the house and garage and away from anything that is combustible. Only put fireplace ashes in your trash container when they are completely cool and after you have put your trash container out on the street for trash pickup. Christmas Tree Pick-ups Dec. 26th through Jan. 24th

hristmas tree pick-ups will begin Dec 26th and will end Jan 24th. Christmas trees will be picked up curbside on the day of your regular service. Please have them out by 6am. Christmas trees may also be dumped at our facility. We request that all Christmas trees over 6 ft tall be cut in half. Additionally, please remove all stands, decorations, and tinsel. If you have a Christmas tree that needs to be picked up after January 24th, please call our office to schedule a greenwaste pick up. You have 4 greenwaste pickups available per year at no additional cost.

HOLIDAY PICK-UP SCHEDULE

Dec. 25th Christmas Day -NO SERVICE: Residents scheduled for a Wednesday pick-up will move to Thursday, Thursday pick-ups will move to Friday, and Friday pick-ups will move to Saturday.

Jan. 1st New Year's Day -NO SERVICE: Residents scheduled for a Wednesday pick-up will move to Thursday, Thursday pick-ups will move to Friday, and Friday pick-ups will move to Saturday.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE 2020

Advance Disposal observes only 6 (six) holidays per year when service is delayed by one day and offices are closed. If a holiday falls on a weekday, trash service will be delayed one day for that week. For example, if a holiday falls on Monday and your pick up day is Tuesday, your trash will be picked up on Wednesday for that particular week only. If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, trash service will NOT be affected.

Wednesday, January 1, 2020 -New Year's Day
Monday, May 25, 2020 -Memorial Day
Saturday, July 4, 2020 -Independence Day SERVICE NOT
